Using Costing Data Through a Quantitative Model in Price Determination on a National Level Basis

The purpose of this paper is to explain the principal role which is played by the Central Unit for Planning and Public Enterprises in price determination on a national level basis. The model used in this paper is a mathematical model suggested about fifteen years ago.

This model is based on several assumptions. Some of these assumptions deal with the costing data available within the economic unit records; while other assumptions deal with some other

data not available in the traditional accounting system. However, some of these assumptions could be eliminated through some more searching and investigation.

The suggested model could be empirically applied through some kind of simulation using a Computer system.
